- ◇ How you got it (Where it was bought/ Who it was from etc.)
- ◇ What you would've bought or used if you hadn't had that
- ◇ The kinds of people who usually have or use that thing
- ◇ The history of that object
- ◇ How it is used
- ◇ Other ways you could use it
- ◇ Where you keep it
- ◇ How long you have had it
- ◇ Other people who have owned it or used it
- ◇ How it compares to similar objects
- ◇ Why it is important to you
- ◇ How often, when and where you use it
- ◇ Memories that are associated with it
- ◇ How long you think you will keep it
- ◇ What you do to keep it safe or in good condition
- ◇ What you will do with it, who you will give it to or leave it to
- ◇ How your life would've been different/ would be different without that thing
