Ask questions about **arrangements, plans and predictions**.

Useful language

This afternoon/ evening/ Tonight

Later (on) today

Tomorrow (morning/ lunchtime/ afternoon/ evening/ night)

The day after tomorrow

Next week/ month/ year/ decade

After...

In ... minutes/ hours/ days/ weeks/ months/ years/ ...

When/ As soon as you retire/ finish this course/ ...

In + *month/ year/ decade/ ...*

At + *time*

On + *day/ date*
