When they have nothing left to say, you can ask them the questions below that they haven't answered (as long as they are relevant to the topic they chose)*

 - ◇ Why you do it
 - ◇ How long you do it for
 - ◇ How much it costs/ How much you spend on it
 - ◇ How often you do it (More or less than in the past?/ More or less in the future?)
 - ◇ How popular it is, in your region, your country and abroad
 - ◇ Who it is popular with
 - ◇ Getting more or less popular?
 - ◇ Changing in any other way?
 - ◇ Different from place to place?
 - ◇ Advantages and disadvantages/ Good points and bad points
 - ◇ Who you'd recommend it to and wouldn't recommend it to
 - ◇ The future of this kind of entertainment
 - ◇ The history of this kind of entertainment (in your country and in the world)
