## **Colours vocabulary necklace**

### **Teacher's instructions**

#### **Making the necklaces**

Choose one of the three worksheets above by whether you just want students to recognise the colour words and touch the right colour, colour in the cards and make them before you do that, or read the words to colour in and do the same. The holes top right and left are to put wool or ribbon through so students can hang the necklaces around their necks, and can be made with a paper cutter or one half of a hole punch. Having the worksheets as just paper makes them too easy to break, so you will probably want to make it stiffer by photocopying onto card, laminating each finished worksheet, or putting each worksheet into an A4 clear sleeve. Alternatively, you can make similar necklaces from wool and clear sleeves that other worksheets can also be put into later.

#### **Ways of using the finished necklaces**

The main purpose is to give students something to do during colour songs like "I can sing a rainbow" in order to keep them involved and to show their comprehension. They can also be used for quiet students to show their understanding of questions like "What colour is a frog?"

#### **Variations**

Another way of making colour necklaces that in fact matches the name much better is to get students to make necklaces from thread and one of each colour of bead in the order you say, and then use that to touch in the way that is described above.
