- Your (paternal/ maternal) grandmother/ grandfather
- Your (oldest/ older/ middle/ younger/ youngest/ baby) brother/ sister
- Your (oldest/ middle/ youngest) son/ daughter
- Your husband/ wife/ partner/ boyfriend/ girlfriend
- Your (best/ oldest/ closest) friend
